

Choose your route and conditions

Cold waters (Anemos)

*

Routes: New York, Quebec, Fécamp, UK

Characteristics:

- Stable temperatures (10°C 18°C)
- Slower and more consistent aging
- Preservation of freshness and balance of aromas

Warm waters (Artemis)



Routes: Colombia, Guadeloupe, Brazil, Cuba

Characteristics:

- Higher temperatures (64°F–81°F)
- Accentuated fruity and rounded notes
- Faster and more expressive aging





Possibility of brushing barrels with seawater*

- Improves wood porosity
- Promotes tannin integration
- Brings conditions closer to those of historical maritime transport

- Perfect for products with a strong identity




Our dedicated space

Continuous monitoring to prevent sudden fluctuations



Wave height & movement

Sensors measuring roll/pitch




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
